## **CAR RIDER PRO**

Dear Parents,  
Over the last couple of months the number of participants of the **CarRiderPro** pick up system has significantly dropped. While it is your choice how you are to pick up your children, there are also some benefits to using the system. One, it is a safer method of pick up. The children are walking to their zones under the supervision of adults inside and outside the Success Academy building. Numerous after school incidents have occurred among the children as they walked towards the library out of adult supervision once they have left the school property. Two, the Hair Ware parking lot is not our property. Hair Ware and the Faith Apostolic Church have asked us before not to block their parking lot during pick up. As good neighbors, I would hope we could fulfill the request. Three, the **CarRider** system is completed very rapidly at this point. At the beginning of the year, it took an astounding 32 minutes to clear the lot. Now that time is cut in 1/2. On average, I start the line about 4:03 and by 4:19, there is no one in the

**CarRider** parking lot. I would ask you to reconsider over the last few weeks of school (and next year) to use this system for safety and for organizational issues. Thank you.
