Smoke alarms save lives. Installing a smoke alarm is the first step to keeping your family safe.

The American Red Cross and its partners have launched the Home Fire Campaign to reduce deaths and injuries caused by home fires by 25 percent over five years. Depending on where you live and other factors, either an American Red Cross representative or one of our partner organizations will contact you to schedule an installation appointment.

If you live in an apartment, check with their office first, as they probably already have alarms installed in their units. **The Red Cross and its partners will install a limited number of free smoke alarms** for those who cannot afford to purchase smoke alarms or for those who are physically unable to install a smoke alarm. The Red Cross installs a limited number of specialized bedside alarms for individuals who are deaf or hard-of-hearing.

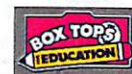
SUCCESS RUNNING CLUB!
