

ESSER III Information – Success Academy South Bend

The United States Congress passed the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III) in March 2021. This relief fund was part of a \$122 billion fund to help school districts impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. Indiana was awarded 1.9 billion of these funds. These funds were then appropriated to school corporations based on a per-pupil formula. The ESSER III grant allocations for Success Academy South Bend are \$2,254,095.99. Per ESSER III guidelines 20% of the approved amount must go towards addressing learning loss. These funds are to be encumbered by September 30, 2024.
